

Yokohama City Scholarship for High School Students

This is a system for providing high school students with a scholarship.

Repayment of this money is not required.

Application requirements

Those who meet (1) through (3) below may apply.

(1) High school student with a guardian living in Yokohama City

* High school students who go to a high school outside of Yokohama City can also apply.

(2) The student had an average grade of 3.50 or higher on the 5 scale in all subjects taken in the previous year

(3) The student has difficulty in attending high school for economic reasons

Amount of scholarship

60,000 yen a year (5,000 yen a month)

* Students who are chosen can get this scholarship yearly until high school graduation.

However, if the student quits school or their guardian moves outside of Yokohama City, they will no longer receive the scholarship. In such case, repayment may be required.

Application procedure

(1) **Consult with the high school before applying for a scholarship.**

(2) Submit the application (document created by the student or a guardian) and documents specifying your bank account information to Yokohama City (in May).

* Submit these documents online or by mail. If submitted online, you can fill out the application form with a smartphone, etc., instead of creating a document.

(3) After submitting the document, submit a copy of the application to the high school.

(4) Submit documents certifying family income* to the high school (in June).

* In addition to the guardian, documents for other people living in the household (grandparents, etc.) are also required.

Screening procedure

Applicants will be chosen up to the predefined maximum, with priority given to households with more difficult economic situations.

Not all applicants are guaranteed to be chosen.

Yearly schedule

March	Publication of application requirements (See the following “Detailed information” page.)
May	Application submission deadline
June	Deadline for documents certifying family income
October	Selection of recipients and scholarship disbursement
